OVERVIEW

As the new 20-21 school year approaches, Panama Middle/High School has implemented new guidelines to ensure the safety of our students and staff. Teachers will assist students with developing important hygiene habits and encouraging social awareness. Our staff will be continuously cleaning and sanitizing the campus throughout the day. SCREENING AND VISITORS

Each day parents and staff must follow the health checklist that is on the district webpage and confirm students and staff DO NOT come to school sick. Students/staff **must** stay home if they have any of the following symptoms: 100 F temperature or higher, coughing, sore throat, loss of smell or taste, shortness of breath, or have been in close contact with a positive COVID case. Temperatures will be taken at each entry point of the Middle/High School. Visitors will not be allowed in the school buildings. Our school building opens at 7:30 am and school begins at 7:55 am. An isolation room has been established if students develop symptoms during school. We will call parents/guardians immediately to have student picked up. We will follow the district criteria to return to school.

COMMUNICATION WITH ALL STAKE HOLDERS
